

- 112. ONE OF OUR FINEST CIVIL WAR RELICS; Scrimshawed Handmade Antler Lime? Container; "101st Regt Indiana Vols Sept 7, 1862 Wabash, Indiana" with an eagle and ribbon; the back says "Milton, Hoovers Gap, Chickamauga, Mission Ridge, Adairsville, Cassville, Dallas, Kenesaw Mountain, Jonesboro, Atlanta"; the crown of the stag is scrimshawed with an acorn and "2d Brig"; the caps are wood; this is a unique centerpiece of any collection; comes from the Harvey Warrner collection; 3-1/4" x 1-3/8"; \$995.00
- 113. US Navy 7" Solid Shot; found at Mobile, Alabama; weighs 42lbs; excellent condition; comes from the Harvey Warrner collection; \$375.00
- 114. Confederate Pierre G. T. Beauregard Autograph and CDV; Confederate General Pierre Gustave Toutant Beauregard (1818-1893) was Commander of the Confederacy's Military Department of South Carolina, Georgia and Florida (1862-1864) and was defending Charleston from attacks by the Union Army and Navy. Beauregard, who had shortened his name to G.T. Beauregard while a student at West Point, had been named a Brigadier General in the Confederate States Army on March 1, 1861 and just a month later, on April 12, 1861, gave the order for Confederate troops to fire on Ft. Sumter, South Carolina, beginning the American Civil War. In addition to the capture of Ft. Sumter, Beauregard distinguished himself in battle at Manassas (July 1861) and Shiloh (April 1862) and would later defeat Union General B.F. Butler at Drewry's Bluff and hold Petersburg (1864) against U.S. Grant until the arrival of Robert E. Lee. Beauregard, who later commanded southern forces against William T. Sherman in Georgia and South Carolina (1864-1865); signed "G. T. Beauregard 1873"; CDV has clipped corners; \$550.00 for the pair


